Cruising:

Each year we plan seven or eight weekend cruises as well as the annual "Retiree's Cruise" the second week in June. This year's event runs from June 12-20. To qualify as a retiree, you simply need to have the time and the desire to go island hopping in the Gulf and San Juan Islands. Both sail and power boats are welcome.

Social Events:

Monthly dinner meetings in May, June, July and September are held at the Peace Arch Park, and in October, November, December, February and March (to be announced). The Commodore's Ball in November. Opening Day ceremonies and sail past in May. Christmas light parade in December.

Racing:

A Comprehensive racing program that features a Fall, Winter and Spring race series as well as two open regatta racing weekends. Flying and non-flying divisions. In addition, we organize rules and tactical seminars.

Privacy Policy Introduction:

Collection of Personal Information:

Use of Personal Information by IYCBC:

All personal information is used by IYCBC only and for the purpose of servicing our members' needs. Unless the Club is advised in writing by a member that they wish to exclude their personal information, the Club has each members consent to disclose the following:

- Name, address, phone numbers and vessel particulars in IYCBC publications.
- Member names and photographs in the Member only side of IYCBC website.
- Details of yachting or IYCBC activities, such as racing and cruising, showing member names, boat name and related event information.

Disclosure of Personal Information:

WE DO NOT disclose, reveal, share or otherwise disseminate any personally identifiable details about you to any third parties except in the following limited circumstances: (a) if required to do so by law, (b) if permitted under the Personal Information Protection Act of British Columbia, or (c) with your prior permission.

Accessing Information:

The accuracy of any personal information collected depends on your willingness to provide it. IYCBC maintains and updates your data according to the information that you willingly provide. You may access any of your own personal information by providing us with a written request.
